Appropriate documentation of league/sport club team must be submitted (including but not limited to photos, program flyers, marketing materials, participant counts, etc.). By applying for this grant, the USTA expects you to make every reasonable effort to develop your sport club and to field a team to compete at the USTA Tennis On Campus Section Championship held in your region.
