recreation through outstanding programming and innovative services that improve student success, build community, and share the important message of health and wellbeing in alignment with NIRSA's priorities.

Open Division: Submissions from any Campus Rec programming area (e.g., Intramurals, Sport Clubs, Member Services, Esports, etc.) are welcome. The review committee will select up to eight recipients annually.

Eligibility: Applicants must meet all of the following criteria.

- Any institution is welcome to apply. Institutional member institutions may apply at no cost. There is an application fee for nonmember institutions.
- Programming must have occurred or been enhanced between May 1, 2023, and April 30, 2025.
- The program may not have received a Campus Rec Innovative Programming Award in the past three years.

Award recipients will be formally recognized via NIRSA media channels, at NIRSA Annual Conference 2026, and may be selected to feature in additional content showcasing thought leadership within the NIRSA community.
